VISITING TEAM - COZAD

- Temperatures will be taken before departing and documented for all team personnel.
- Face coverings will be worn by all team members when not in the game.
- Face coverings will be worn by coaches at all times.
- Team Personnel are only allowed on the bench.
 - Team members should have appropriate physical distancing on team benches.
- Team members should have designated spaces for their personal belongings.
- Water will not be provided.
 - Each athlete and coach will bring their own water bottle/water jugs.
- Balls - Both teams should bring as many game balls that they need for all games. You will use your own balls while playing defense throughout the triangular.
- Social distancing is expected to be followed.
- No pre-game and post-game handshakes/high-fives/fist bumps.
 - Sportsmanship can still be shown between teams without physical contact.
- No post-game talks in the field area are allowed. Team personnel and fans must leave the area.
- Cozad is responsible for bringing their own disinfectant.

VISITING TEAM FANS - COZAD

- Immediate family members strongly encouraged.
 - Parents/Guardians, siblings, spouses, grandparents, and others living in the same household with a coach or player.
 - Individuals must attempt to maintain an arm's length physical distance and avoid congregating.
- All individuals are required to wear a face covering that covers their nose and mouth at all times.
- All individuals are expected to conduct a self-screen prior to coming to the event.
 - If you are ill, please do not attend.
- Seating: All Cozad spectators will sit along the 3rd base line and left field. Please see the attached map for seating areas.
 - Spectators should bring their own chairs.

HOME TEAM FANS - GOTHENBURG

DUGOUTS

- The visiting team dugout is located on the 3rd baseline and home team along the 1st baseline.
- Both home and visitor dugouts will be extended allowing the teams to spread out.
 - Bring extra chairs or buckets to sit on in the extended space if needed.

RESTROOMS

- Porta-Potties for Cozad's teams and fans will be located in the south parking lot.
- Restrooms for Gothenburg's team and fans will be located in the building behind home plate.

LOCKER ROOMS

- No locker rooms are available. Please come dressed to play.

CLEANING & DISINFECTING

- Balls will be cleaned by teams during the contests by each team.
 - We will utilize opportunities during stopped or transition play periods.

ENTRANCES/EXITS

- Spectators will enter through the south parking lot.
- Face coverings are required when entering the facility and remain on during the contest.
- Spectators should maintain an arm's length physical distance and avoid congregating at all times.

TICKET TAKERS

- All event staff are required to wear face coverings.
- Gloves will be worn when handling money.

EVENT PERSONNEL

- All event staff are required to wear face coverings.

OFFICIALS

- Wear face coverings other than when working the contest.
- Symptom check with Mr. Mroczek, Activities Director.
- Come dressed when possible.

MEDIA

- Media personnel are required to wear face coverings at all times.
- Media personnel must stay outside the fence and maintain physical distance from others that may be in attendance.
- NSAA media credentials are required to be on.
 - We will accept 2019-2020 NSAA credentials and 2020/2021 NSAA Media Credentials.

CONCESSIONS

- Concessions will **not** be provided. Please plan accordingly.

TEAM MEALS

- Team meals will not be allowed before, during, or after games on all Gothenburg facilities.
 - Includes home and away teams.
