

## Covid Information

Amherst Public Schools is implementing the following procedures in regards to activities held at Amherst. These guidelines are subject to change depending on the risk level for Amherst Public Schools.

### **Indoor Events: Volleyball**

- Fans are required to wear a mask at all times within the school building. Exceptions are made for children that are younger than school aged and those who are unable to wear a mask due to health issues. A doctor's note stating such accommodations must be provided.
- Concession stand will be open; workers will wear masks and gloves to serve. Anyone wishing to purchase something from the concession stand will need to wear a mask. Once a spectator purchases their food or drink we ask they return to their seat and eat/drink the item. They may unmask to do so but once the food/drink is consumed, then the mask needs to be put back on.
- Student section allowed if wearing masks.
- All spectators are encouraged to practice social distancing.
- Visiting cheerleaders allowed if wearing masks.
- Children must stay with parents.
- No pep band indoors.

### **Sport Specific Guidelines Volleyball**

- Visiting teams will be given a locker room and allowed to use shower facilities. They need to wear masks while not competing.
- Visiting teams are strongly encouraged to take temperatures prior to leaving home facilities.
- No switching benches between sets.
- Pre game or post game no handshakes per NSSA and NFHS guidelines.
- Officials will wear masks during pregame meetings.
- Players can wear a mask during competition

#### Additional Information

- If a school has a player test positive for COVID-19, they will contact Two Rivers Health department or their local Health Department.
- It is our recommendation that players, coaches, and spectators check their temperatures at home and prior to entering our facilities. Any individual with a temp of 100.4 or greater should not be in attendance.
- Those that have underlying health conditions are encouraged not to attend games.

- Fans are required to leave the facility immediately following the conclusion of the final game of the evening.
- All events during the school day will follow the current school guidelines that are in place.
- Attendance guidelines will be followed according to the risk level for Amherst Public Schools.
- Amherst athletes temperatures will be taken before loading the bus for away games.
