Admission: **Admission is \$6.00 for ADULTS AND \$4.00 for STUDENTS.** Coaches and bus drivers will be admitted free of charge School Administrators admitted free of charge; Please ID Self. Those in 8th grade or under who participate in the Youth Night may enter without the admission fee.

Temp. Checks: We request that temperatures be taken prior to departure of the visiting team. Please verify for all team personnel. STC softball players will be temperature checked throughout the school day.

Dugouts: Visiting dugout is located (first base line). Both home and visitor dugouts will be extended allowing the teams to spread out. Bring extra chairs or buckets to sit on in the extended space if needed. Cleaning supplies will be provided for foul balls / surfaces.

Water will NOT be provided - please bring your own.

Warm up: Visiting team can warm up alongside the first base line.

Pre-game: The National Anthem will take place prior to the Varsity game.

Parking: Team buses may unload athletes next to the East entrance in the drop off zone (See Attached Map) and park along the back of the parking lot.

Seating: Visiting Spectators: will sit / stand along the first base line outside the fence or in the right field area.

STC Spectators: will sit / stand along the 3rd base line outside the fence or in the left field area outside the fence.

Concessions: Will be available in the complex

Restrooms: Located in the Middle of Smith Complex
 *Effective cleaning and disinfecting of all restrooms periodically

Locker Rooms: No locker rooms available; Please come dressed to play.

Post Game: When games end, the leaving team must sanitize the dugout or bench area. No post-game talks at the field are permitted. Fans and players must leave the playing area.

Officials: The officials for Thursday evening’s game are Dave Kreuger and Partner

Miscellaneous: It is required that spectators and team personnel wear face coverings. It is also recommended that spectators conduct a self-screen prior to entering.
